## IMPORTANT VOTING INFORMATION FOR THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the State of New Jersey has ordered the 2020 NJ General Election be completed primarily through a **VOTE-BY-MAIL** system. **VOTING MACHINES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE ON ELECTION DAY**, except for voters who attest to being unable to use a paper ballot due to a disability.

For the upcoming 2020 General Election on Nov. 3, **all registered voters** in the State of New Jersey **will AUTOMATICALLY receive a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot and a prepaid envelope**, regardless of political affiliation or past voting method.

The Burlington County Clerk will begin mailing VBM ballots and prepaid envelopes to all registered Voters in Burlington County by the first week of October, 2020.

## RETURNING YOUR BALLOT

Once a voter has automatically received their official VBM ballot through the mail, there are four options to return the VBM ballot prior to or on Election Day:

1. Evesham voters can return their VBM ballot through the U.S. Postal Service using the prepaid envelope that arrives with the ballot. Please remember to follow provided instructions. All VBM ballots mailed through the U.S. Postal Service must show valid postmark dated before or on November 3, 2020.
2. Evesham voters can drop their VBM ballot in any secured drop box that has been installed at locations throughout Burlington County. The full list of locations for Burlington County can be viewed at <https://www.nj.gov/state/elections/vote-secure-drop-boxes.shtml>

**NOTE:** A drop box has been installed outside the entrance to the Evesham Township Municipal Building at 984 Tuckerton Road and is monitored 24 hours a day, seven days a week. All VBM ballots placed in the drop box locations are picked up by officials regularly.

3. Voters can drop their VBM ballot at the drop box in front of the Burlington County Board of Elections, located at 50 Rancocas Road, Mount Holly.
4. Voters can bring (only) their own completed and sealed VBM ballot to **their designated polling place** (see next page) on Election Day, Nov. 3, from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Those dropping off their VBM ballot must sign in with poll workers. Only voters who attest to being disabled and unable to use a paper ballot will be allowed to access a voting machine at a physical polling location. Voters without disabilities who are not returning their VBM ballot will only be allowed to fill out a PAPER, PROVISIONAL BALLOT at a physical polling location.
