Ordinances, Resolutions, and Motions

The legislation listed below pertains to the purchase of property at 100 and 102 Sharp Road. This 15 acre property and existing facilities will be the future home of the Department of Public Works. The purchase price is \$6,100,000. The Township will retain the tenants currently renting space at the property; therefore, rental income, combined with the sale of the existing DPW facility, means this complex will be tax neutral and pay for itself over the course of the bond. The move will ultimately increase the DPW's work area by 70%.

Resolution No. 220-2016: Resolution Approving Agreement of Sale for Block 14, Lots 5 and 5.03 (100 and 120 Sharp Road) - Adopted by Township Council at the meeting of July 26, 2016 by a vote of 5-0. This resolution authorizes the execution of agreement between the Township of Evesham and Mr. Lipinski of 100 Sharp Road, LLC.

Ordinance No. 16-8-2016: Bond Ordinance Authorizing the Acquisition of Certain Real Property and the Improvements Thereon, the Completion of Various Capital Improvements and the Acquisition and Installation of Various Capital Equipment as Part of the New Public Works Complex in and for the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, New Jersey; Appropriating the Sum of \$6,700,000 Therefor; Authorizing the Issuance of General Obligation Bonds or Bond Anticipation Notes of the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, New Jersey, in the Aggregate Principal Amount of up to \$6,380,000; Making Certain Determinations and Covenants; and Authorizing Certain Related Actions in Connection with the Foregoing - Adopted by a vote of 5-0 at the meeting of August 16, 2016. This ordinance contains a breakdown of the sum of \$6,700,000 anticipated to complete the facility and the specific purposes designated for the same.

Ordinance No. 17-8-2016: An Ordinance of the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, Authorizing the Acquisition of Certain Property Known as Block 14, Lots 5 and 5.03 (100 and 120 Sharp Road) - This ordinance was adopted at the meeting of August 16, 2016 by a vote of 5-0 and allows for the acquisition of the aforementioned property as authorized in N.J.S.A 40A: 12-3 and 40A: 12-6. In essence, this statute grants a municipality the ability to purchase property for the performance of local government functions deemed necessary by Township Council.

Council's Corner



In this issue, we feature Councilwoman Deb Hackman who has served on Township Council since 2009. Ms. Hackman is responsible for establishing the Evesham Youth Advisory Committee which

began in 2011 as a way to support and nurture the next generations of leaders. The Evesham Youth Advisory Committee, or YAC, comprises of members from the Evesham Youth community ranging from 6th to 12th grades. Members of YAC develop a variety of skills through volunteering, participating in civic projects, and learning about the town they live in. YAC members participate regularly in road clean-ups, volunteer at Evesham Community Events, and work directly with other members of the community to improve their hometown. Ms. Hackman has been instrumental in expanding YAC, and facilitating projects that promote leadership and civic responsibility for future generations. Ms. Hackman also volunteers her time with many organizations in both Evesham Township and in Burlington County.

Grant Applications

2013 County Grant: The remaining funds of this grant will go toward establishing a tennis wall at Heathrow Park. Other monies secured from this grant have gone towards improving various Township parks and other outdoor areas.

CDBG Grant: The Township utilized CDBD funding to create handicapped access ramps in the Tara neighborhood. This funding will help assist those in need.

Drunk Driving Enforcement: The ETPD received funding from the State to pay for the salaries and equipment in further of DWI enforcement in the Township.

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Did You Know?

In accordance with New Jersey State law, the Township processes bingo and raffle applications, as well as social affair permits. As we are now entering the busy season for such events, please see below for more information.

Bingo and Raffles: Chapter 83 of the Township Code authorizes the Township Clerk to act as the issuing authority of bingo and raffle licenses. These licenses are available only to non-profit organizations. To apply for a license that will be used in Evesham Township, an application, completed with appropriate fees and a registration certificate from the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission at the State, must be delivered to the Clerk's Office at least a month prior to the event for proper processing and State approval. If you are planning a game of chance, please call the Clerk's Office for more information.

Social Affair Permits: Social Affair Permits are available to non-profit organizations holding an event in which alcohol will be served (excluding events operating under a liquor license issued by the State). All Social Affair Applications are now to be made under the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control's website under the "licensing/permits" tab. All applications must be made **at least 21 days prior** to the event. If an organization is unable to make this deadline, then a **paper application** must be filed with the Clerk's Office to be processed. On the municipal level, Social Affair Permits are subject to the approval of the Evesham Township Chief of Police and the Township Council at a regularly scheduled Council Meeting.

Voting Deadlines:

- **October 18, 2016** - Register to Vote. This includes first time voters, change of address, and name changes.
- **November 1, 2016** - Apply for Mail-In Ballots (Absentee Ballots). The County will begin the commencement of mailing Mail-In Ballots on September 24, 2016.
- **November 7, 2016** - In-Person Mail-In Ballot Application. Due by 3:00PM in the County Clerk's Office.
