Bids must be made on the Township's proposal form and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the outside addressed to the Township of Evesham, Office of the Township Clerk, Municipal Complex, 984 Tuckerton Road, Marlton, New Jersey 08053. Bids shall be accepted no later than **10:00 AM** at the Township Clerk's office, Room 201. **The bidder shall also provide an exact copy of the bid documents on a USB flash drive in the bid envelope.**

All bids must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid but not in excess of \$20,000, and be delivered to the place and by the hour above named.

Bidders shall submit a Certificate (Consent of Surety) with Power of Attorney for the total amount of the bid from a Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the owner stating that it will provide said bidder with a Performance Bond in the full amount of the bid. Failure to submit a bid bond or consent of surety form shall result in rejection of the bid.

The Township will not assume responsibility for bids mailed in.

The Township reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive technical defects and make the award to the bidder most competent to serve the Township's requirements.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq., N.J.S.A. 17:27 (Affirmative Action), and Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101, et.seq.).

Sealed bids will be received by the Township of Evesham at 10:00 AM on, February 4, 2026, in Conference Room "B" of the Township Municipal Complex, 984 Tuckerton Road, Marlton, New Jersey 08053, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the provision of EVESHAM MOWING AND LANDSCAPE SERVICES as set forth in the specifications attached hereto.

1. Bids must be on the proposal sheet furnished by the Township and shall be enclosed in sealed envelope addressed to the Township Clerk, 984 Tuckerton Road, Marlton, NJ 08053 with the front of the envelope marked with the name and address of the bidder and the words "2026" EVESHAM MOWING AND LANDSCAPE SERVICES". **The bidder shall also provide an exact copy of the bid documents on a USB flash drive in the bid envelope.**
2. All bidders must complete and forward with the bid a non-collusion affidavit, W-9 form and a corporate disclosure statement setting forth the name and address of all stockholders or partners owning 10% or more stock or interest of the bidder in a corporation or partnership.
3. Bidder shall submit with the bid a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total price bid, but not in excess of \$20,000, payable unconditionally to the owner. When submitting a Bid Bond, it shall contain Power of Attorney for the full amount of Bid Bond from a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the owner. The bid shall also contain a Certificate (Consent of Surety) with a Power of Attorney for the full amount of the bid price from a Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey. This certificate shall confirm that the bidder to whom the contract is awarded shall furnish performance bonds in the full amount of the contract. For the sole purpose of computing the bid bond and consent of surety, bidders shall multiply the sum of all bid totals for the scope of services by 26 to provide an estimated contract price for the initial one (1) year contract term. For the one-year renewal of the contract thereafter, the bidder shall multiply its bid pricing by 26 to provide an estimated contract amount for the subsequent performance bond. Failure to submit the aforementioned bid security shall result in rejection of the bid.
4. The Township Council intends to award the contract within 60 days form the receipt of bids and reserves the right to reject any or all bids as may be in the best interest of the Township of Evesham.
5. If the bidder's specifications for furnishing products or equipment are, in any respect, not the equivalent of the detailed Township specifications, this discrepancy must specifically be called to the attention of the Township in the bidder's proposal.
6. Unless otherwise specified, the cost of the bid shown shall be the cost to the Township at the grass cutting locations designated in the attached map.
7. The award shall not be binding upon the Township until the contract has been executed by the Township, nor shall any work be performed on account of the proposed contract until the contract has been duly executed and delivered.

8. All bidders shall comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-30 through 38 and P.L. 1975, C. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17.27). An executed copy of "Exhibit A" "Mandatory Affirmative Action Language" must be submitted with the bid proposal.
9. Each bidder shall submit unit prices for any item listed on the bid proposal sheet and said unit prices shall cover all costs of any nature, incident to and growing out of the work, and as specified in the specifications.
10. Only manufactured and farm products of the United States, wherever available shall be used.
11. Within ten (10) days of the date that the Township notifies the successful bidder or bidders of acceptance of the bid, the successful bidder shall execute the contract.
12. The Township reserves the right to select different vendors for specific items that would be in the best interest of the Township of Evesham.
13. Purchases shall be on an as-needed basis with no aggregate requirement to be purchase by the Township of Evesham.
14. All bids shall comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

#### **GOODS, PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AND GENERAL SERVICE CONTRACTS**

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that such applicants are recruited and employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative or workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union or workers' representative of the contractor's commitments under this act and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to employ minority and women workers consistent with the applicable county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2, or a binding determination of the applicable county employment goals determined by the Division, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the applicable employment goals, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

**AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990**  
**Equal Opportunity for Individuals with Disability**

The contractor and the Township of Evesham, (hereafter "owner") do hereby agree that the provisions of Title 11 of the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 (the "Act") (42 U.S.C. S121 01 et seq.), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities in all services, programs, and activities provided or made available by public entities, and the rules and regulations promulgated pursuant there unto, are made a part of this contract. In providing any aid, benefit, or service on behalf of the owner pursuant to this contract, the contractor agrees that the performance shall be in strict compliance with the Act. In the event that the contractor, its agents, servants, employees, or subcontractors violate or are alleged to have violated the Act during the performance of this contract, the contractor shall defend the owner in any action or administrative proceeding commenced pursuant to this Act. The contractor shall indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner, its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages, of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of the alleged violation. The contractor shall, at its own expense, appear, defend, and pay any and all charges for legal services and any and all costs and other expenses arising from such action or administrative proceeding or incurred in connection therewith. In any and all complaints brought pursuant to the owner's grievance procedure, the contractor agrees to abide by any decision of the owner which is rendered pursuant to said grievance procedure. If any action or administrative proceeding results in an award of damages against the owner, or if the owner incurs any expense to cure a violation of the ADA which has been brought pursuant to its grievance procedure, the contractor shall satisfy and discharge the same at its own expense.

The owner shall, as soon as practicable after a claim has been made against it, give written notice thereof to the contractor along with full and complete particulars of the claim, If any action or administrative proceeding is brought against the owner or any of its agents, servants, and employees, the *owner shall* expeditiously forward or have forwarded to the contractor every demand, complaint, notice, summons, pleading, or other process received by the owner or its representatives.

It is expressly agreed and understood that any approval by the owner of the services provided by the contractor pursuant to this contract will not relieve the contractor of the obligation to comply with the Act and to defend, indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner pursuant to this paragraph.

It is further agreed and understood that the owner assumes no obligation to indemnify or save harmless the contractor, its agents, servants, employees and subcontractors for any claim which may arise out of their performance of this Agreement. Furthermore, the contractor expressly understands and agrees that the provisions of this indemnification clause shall in no way limit the contractor's obligations assumed in this Agreement, nor shall they be construed to relieve the contractor from any liability, nor preclude the owner from taking any other actions available to it under any other provisions of the Agreement or otherwise at law.

**PROOF OF BUSINESS REGISTRATION:** N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 requires that each bidder (contractor) submit proof of business registration with the bid proposal. Proof of registration shall be a copy of the bidder's Business Registration Certificate (BRC). A BRC is obtained from the New Jersey Division of Revenue. Information on obtaining a BRC is available on the internet at [www.nj.gov/njbgs](http://www.nj.gov/njbgs) or by phone at (609) 292-1730. N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 imposes the following requirements on contractors and all subcontractors that **knowingly** provide goods or perform services for a contractor fulfilling this contract:

- 1). The contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors and suppliers to submit proof of business registration to the contractor;
- 2). Prior to receipt of final payment from a contracting agency, a contractor must submit to the contracting agency an accurate list of all subcontractors or attest that none were used.
- 3). During the term of this contract, the contractor and its affiliates shall collect and remit, and shall notify all subcontractors and their affiliates that they must collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act, (N.J.S.A.54:32B-1 et seq.) on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State.

The contractor shall provide mowing, edging and trimming services as well as mulching and general landscape maintenance as needed to areas designated by the Township through the contract administrator who will be the **Superintendent Of Recreation and Open Space**. The contract administrator has the authority to increase or decrease mowing frequency as needed based on conditions such as weather, disease, special events or other factors.

The contractor is to provide all tools, labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work in accordance with the contract. The contractor shall cut in such a pattern as to avoid scalping the grass. The contractor is to ensure that all equipment is in proper working order and that all mowing blades will be kept sharp to ensure a clean and even cut. The contractor is responsible for supplying the proper equipment to mow on a graded surface when necessary.

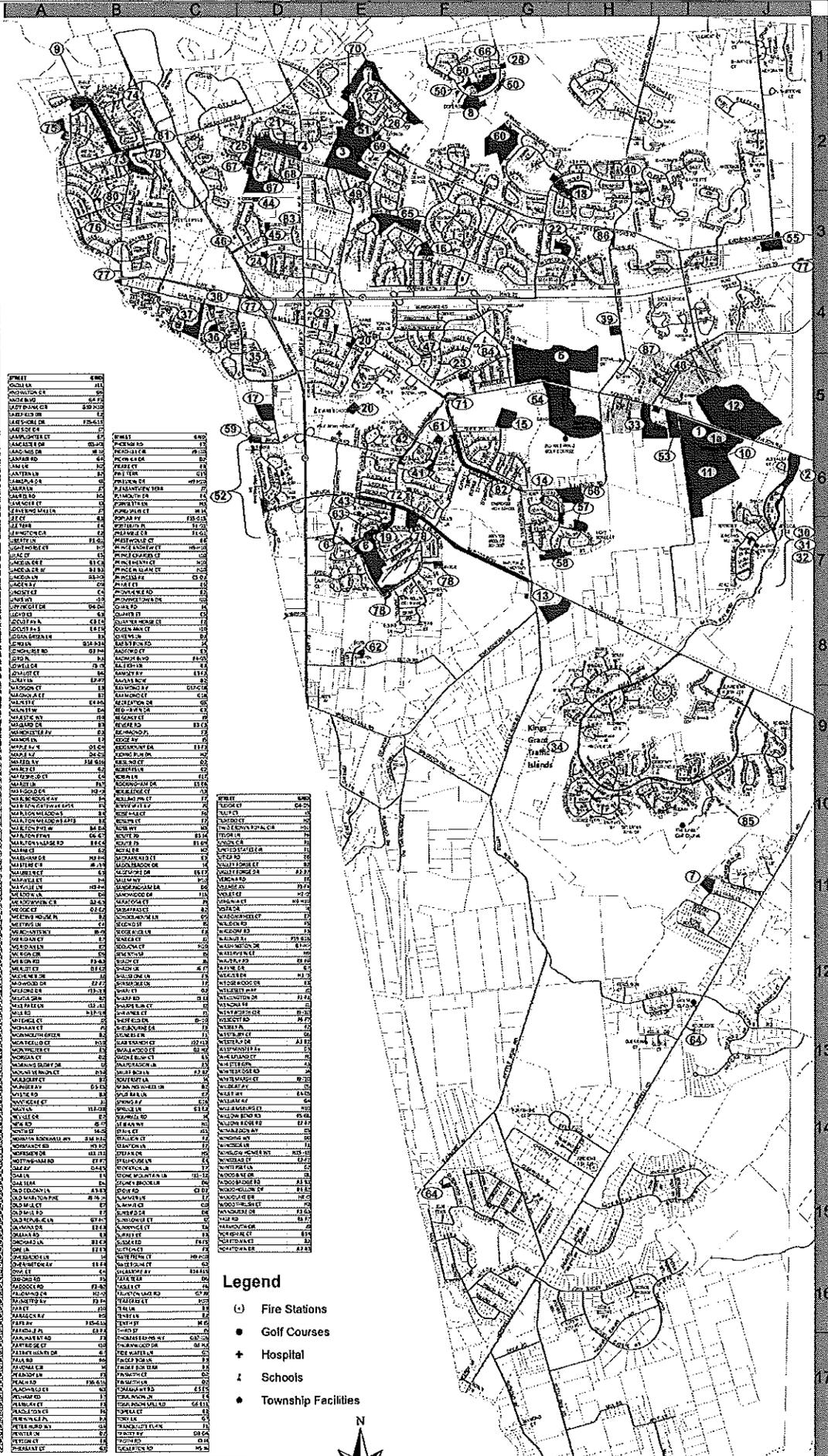
