PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Evesham Township Planning Board will conduct a Public Hearing on February 19, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Building Council Chambers at 984 Tuckerton Road, Marlton, NJ, pursuant to the Municipal Land Use Law (N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1, et seq.), and specifically N.J.S.A. 40:55D-13 and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-28, to consider adopting a report entitled 2026 Master Plan Reexamination Report and Master Plan Amendment 2026 prepared by Taylor Design Group Inc.

The 2026 Master Plan Reexamination Report and Master Plan Amendment is being considered pursuant to the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-89. Following the public hearing, the Planning Board may further act to adopt the 2026 Master Plan Reexamination Report and Master Plan Amendment to the Township's Master Plan.

The 2026 Master Plan Reexamination Report and Master Plan Amendment will be on file and available for public inspection during normal business hours in the Office of Community Development and on the Township's website <https://evesham-nj.org/boards/planning> a minimum of ten days before the hearing.

At the hearing an overview of the 2026 Master Plan Reexamination Report and Master Plan Amendment will be presented and the Planning Board will hear public comments.

Any person affected by or interested in this matter will have the opportunity during the hearing to present any comments to the Planning Board as well as to ask questions and cross-examine all witnesses.
