AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM
ADOPTING CHAPTER 162 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM ENTITLED "DEER
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM," AND AMENDING CHAPTER
110 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM
ENTITLED "PARKS" AND CHAPTER 72 OF THE CODE
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM ENTITLED "FEES"
RELATED TO WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

Public notice is hereby given that the foregoing ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading at the Township Council meeting of the Township of Evesham held on May 6, 2026. This ordinance serves to establish the regulations of hunting activities on certain Evesham Township owned properties in accordance with the applicable laws, regulations, and any additional rules or permits established by the Township of Evesham and the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife in an effort to implement managed reduction of the local deer population, to preserve natural resources, and to protect residents.

Further notice is given that said ordinance will be considered for final passage and adoption, after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of the Township Council to be held in the Court Room located at 984 Tuckerton Road, Marlton, New Jersey, on June 10, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of said meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Township Clerk's Office for members of the general public to request the same.
