110 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM  
ENTITLED "PARKS" AND CHAPTER 72 OF THE CODE  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM ENTITLED "FEES"  
RELATED TO WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

Please take notice that at the Township Council Meeting of June 10, 2026, a public hearing was held on the above-entitled Ordinance of the Township of Evesham in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey. The vote on said Ordinance was tabled to the Township Council Meeting to be held on July 8, 2026 at 7:00 P.M. in the Municipal Court Room located at 984 Tuckerton Road, Marlton, New Jersey, at which time and place the Township Council will consider said final passage and adoption, after a public hearing thereon. This ordinance serves to establish the regulations of hunting activities on certain Evesham Township owned properties in accordance with the applicable laws, regulations, and any additional rules or permits established by the Township of Evesham and the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife in an effort to implement managed reduction of the local deer population, to preserve natural resources, and to protect residents.
