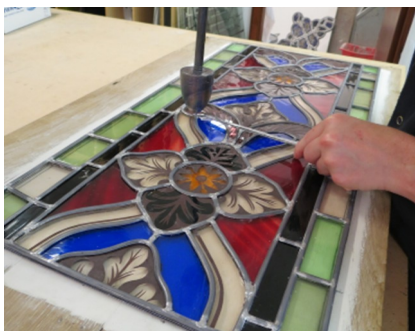

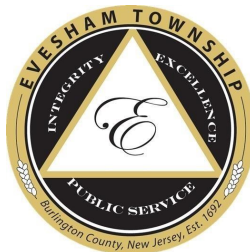


PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION
