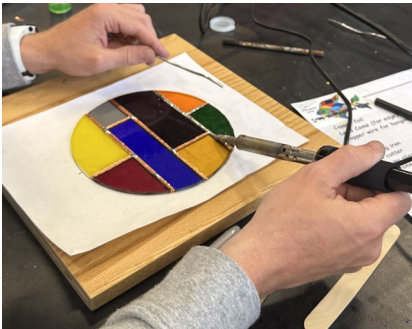

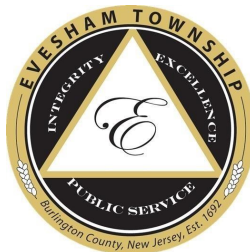


## PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION
