REQUEST A VACATION PROPERTY CHECK



The Evesham Police Department offers vacation house checks as a complimentary service to the citizens of Evesham. The Evesham Police Department will conduct periodic checks of your Evesham residence while you are out of town, for a period of up to 21 days.

Let's work together to prevent break-ins while you are away on vacation.

It is recommended that Evesham residents follow these simple steps in order to better safeguard their home.

For instance;

- Have good locks on all doors and windows and use them.
- Make sure your residence locks lived in, not empty.
- Leave shades and blinds in a normal position.
- Ask a neighbor to watch your residence while you're away.
- Test your smoke and burglar alarms.
- Stop all deliveries, arrange for a neighbor to pick up your mail, newspaper and packages.
- Have a neighbor place garbage cans at the curb on your normal pickup day(s) and return them after the garbage pickup is made.
- Plug in timers to turn lights and a radio or television on and off at appropriate times.
- Don't announce your absence on answering machines or your social media sites
- Close and lock garage doors and windows. Park a car in your driveway or ask a neighbor to occasionally park in your driveway.
- Consider taking valuables to a bank safety deposit box.
- Ask the Evesham Police to place your home on their vacation check list.

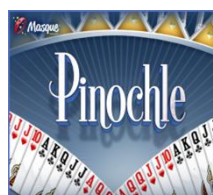
MARLTON SENIOR CITIZENS CLUB

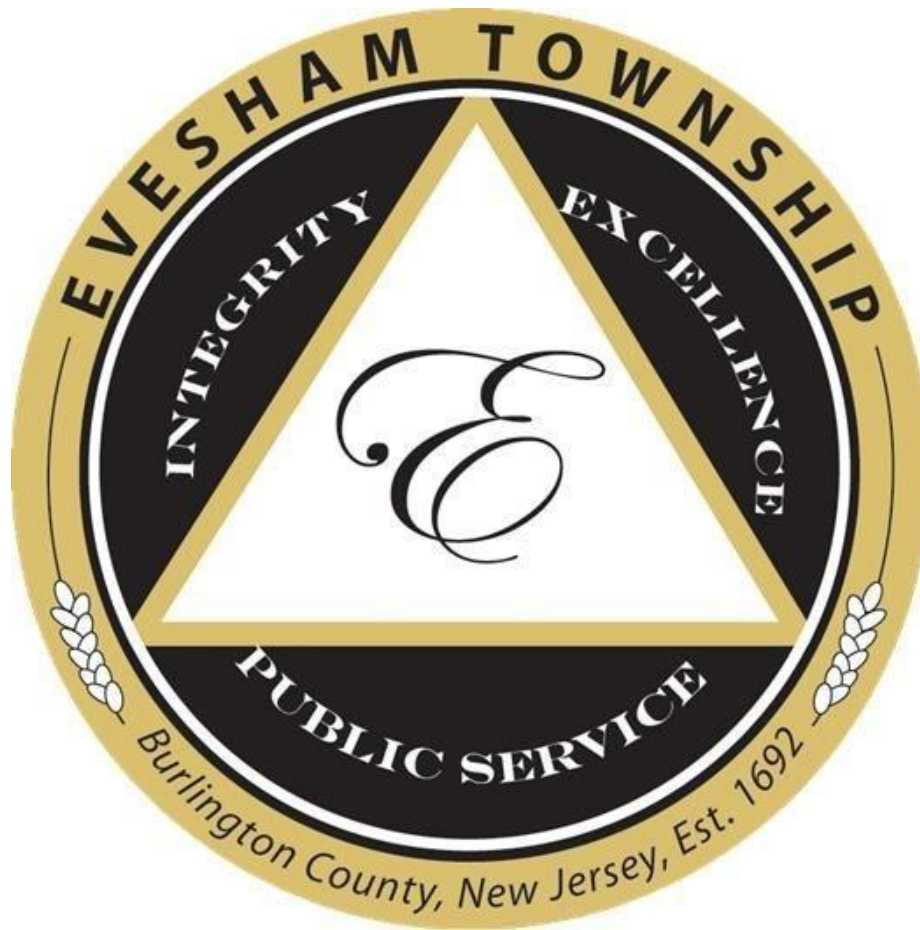
