Demolition of Inground Pools

Required Permits:

- Zoning Permit Application copy of survey and third-party letter providing certification describing the type of material and location (source) of importation of fill and that the fill is clean and free of debris. There is no fee for the Zoning Permit Application.
- Construction Permit Application with a Building Subcode Technical Form completed for removal of inground pool.

Rules for Clean Fill:

Only clean fill is permitted as backfill. If the homeowner desires to use the concrete pool material as fill, the concrete must be no larger than 3"-4" in diameter and all debris that is not concrete, brick, or block must be removed, including all rebar, vinyl, wood, etc.

Cost of Permit:

Construction Permits for demolition of inground pools cost \$168.00. You will be asked to pay this fee at the end of our review. The fee must be paid prior to work commencing.

Required Inspections:

- Inspection prior to backfill
- Final inspection

Prior to Certificate of Approval All Prior Requirements Must be Met:

- 1. Copy of survey and third party letter providing certification describing the type of material used.
- 2. Required inspections.
