

In 2022, the Evesham EC made it happen!!!

OPEN SPACE

- Spent at least two months and a copious number of hours researching and identifying land parcels for acquisition
- Provided our land parcel acquisition recommendations to the township which will be included in the updates to the OSRP
- At the request of The Garden Club of Marlton, worked to help them apply for a tree grant

SITE PLAN REVIEWS

- Reviewed and provided comments on at least a half-dozen site applications and attended most of the meetings for which we provided comments

CROFT FARM

- Mowed the perimeter around Croft Farm during the summer months
- Monitored 6 nest boxes at Croft Farm
- Reported monthly on the birds at Croft Farm

OUTREACH

- Coordinated and participated in the annual tree giveaway
- Performed stream assessments and stream cleanups in the Rancocas Watershed
- Offered a rain barrel workshop for the community teaming with up with the Watershed Ambassador program
- Officially opened New Road Trail
- Led a guided tour of New Road Trail for 20+ attendees
- Applied for, received and planted a sapling from the historic Salem Oak Tree
- Tabled at Night Out
- Developed an information flyer for the Evesham EC to be used at tabling events and for display on the EC's web page

GRANTS

- Applied for and received a Sustainable Jersey grant for raised bed pollinator gardens at the Community Garden

In 2022, the Evesham EC made it happen!!! (cont.)

MAINTENANCE SUPPORT

- At the request of the Open Space and Recreation Department, researched and planted native plants at the municipal building
- Weeded the MUA rain gardens (on numerous occasions)
- Monitored and reported on the newly installed rain gardens at the Blue Barn
- Supported the winterization of the cisterns at the Blue Barn and Kings Grant Fire Station
- Maintained New Road Trail until the township was able to take over
- Maintained the pollinator garden at Vant Zant park

SUSTAINABLE JERSEY

- Achieved Bronze Certification

SUBCOMMITTEES

- Instituted 3 subcommittees: Site Plan Review, BRP, and Beagle Club

ADVISORY CORRESPONDENCE

- Made the following recommendations to the township:
 - Recommended solar on the driving range changes and native plants
 - Recommended that the township write a letter of support in opposition to the LNG terminal in Gibbstown
 - Recommended reduced mowing on the open space across from New Road Trail entrance
 - Recommended our design preferences and preferred focus on less development and more open space at the Beagle Club

FBRP

- Acted as liaison to the FBRP
- Developed a draft flowchart to support a process for reviewing proposals from the FBRP
- Reviewed and commented on the FBRP's Restoration Project at the BRP

About Us

The Evesham Environmental Commission:

- Created by the Township Council in 1978 for the protection, development, or use of natural resources within Evesham Township.
- Comprised of seven regular and two alternate members, who are appointed by the mayor.
- Provides recommendations to the Township Council concerning open space, water resources, air pollution control, solid waste management, soil and landscape protection, and protection of flora and fauna.
- Advisory to the Planning Board and Zoning Board of Adjustment in the case of development applications and land use.
- Conducts research into the use and possible use of the open land areas of the municipality and maintains an index of all open spaces.
- Develops / updates a Shade Tree Master Plan for the care, preservation, pruning, replanting, removal or disposition of trees and shrubs along the streets, in parks and in other public places.
- Provides an annual report to the governing body.

Successful Initiatives of the EEC:

- Providing recommendations for Evesham's Township Council, Planning Board, and Zoning Board to ensure the preservation and care of Evesham's environment
- Rain garden, bird box, and/or pollinator garden installations at the Blue Barn, Elmwood MUA, Croft Farm, Evesboro Downs, Evesham Municipal Building, and Van Zant Open Space Area
- Free Tree Giveaways, providing over 1,000 saplings (and counting) for local residents, courtesy of the NJ DEP
- Partnerships with other organizations, such as the Black Run Preserve, Pinelands Preservation Alliance, local Girl Scouts, and others



Evesham Environmental Commission Priorities for 2023

- Updates to the Tree Ordinance
- Support the final publication of the Open Space and Recreation Plan (OSRP)
- Review and comment on Site Plans and FBRP projects
- Include a student liaison to the Environmental Commission (EC)
- Maintenance Manual for green infrastructure and selected open spaces area
- Final report for Croft Farm post the 18-month pilot
- Attend council meetings and speak on EC's accomplishments as they occur
- Open the Croft Farm walking path to the public

We will supplement our priorities with:

- our usual *education and outreach* activities like the tree give away, tabling events, requests for informational signs, native plantings, etc. and
 - *maintenance activities* for various open space initiatives that we have initiated
